



2017 Scholarship Rules

Rules Governing this Scholarship:

1. The recipient shall be a young man or woman who has resided in WV for at least four years prior to the date of the award and merits recognition for training beyond the high school level in a health related post-high school training program.
2. A scholarship of \$1,000.00 will be granted to two freshmen entering a two or four year college program. The award will be sent directly to the college or university of choice to offset the student's educational expenses (i.e. tuition, room and board, books).
3. Applications shall be made directly to the Scholarship Committee of the Davis Medical Center Auxiliary.
4. The applicant shall submit, in addition to the application, the following by noon on Friday, March 10, 2017.
 - a. Three (3) letters of recommendation: Two from teachers and one from a community member (not a relative) who knows the applicant.
 - b. An official high school transcript and transcript(s) of any acquired college credits to date. Include a list of current semester classes.
 - c. Lists of high school and community activities. Please include list of hours served for each activity or location. (community activities must include volunteer service to a health related program)
 - d. An essay of 500 words or less outlining the applicant's future educational/career goals, why this field of study is of interest to the applicant, and expressing his/her need and desire to be awarded the particular scholarship.
 - e. ACT scores: Composite, English, Math, Reading, & Science
 - f. A brief description of the applicant's senior project. (if project is required by your school)

- g. The application checklist to verify inclusion of all requested information.**

Criteria:

The applicant will be judged on the following:

- a. Overall grade point average, references and essay**
- b. Extracurricular and /or community activities**
- c. Resident of Randolph, Barbour, Upshur, Pocahontas, Tucker or Webster County at the time of the application.**
- d. Demonstrates a sincere desire to attain certification or degree**
- e. All requested items have been turned in with the application**

Semi-finalists will be notified and interviewed after April 3, 2017.
